KS2 Pupils Agreement/Online Safety

Please read and discuss these rules with your child before signing at the bottom of the page. Thank you.

- ✓ I will only use the internet when a trusted adult is around to help and will not deliberately look for or access inappropriate websites.
 - ✓ I will only bring mobile phones and other storage devices if it is necessary and I have permission from home and school, these will be kept in the office and must be handed in at the office as soon as I arrive at school.
 - ✓ I will only use programmes and content which have been installed by the school and adults.
 - ✓ I will always ask permission before using the internet and online tools e.g. chat.
 - ✓ I will immediately minimise any page I am uncomfortable with and tell an adult.
 - ✓ I will only communicate with people a trusted adult has approved and if I receive a message sent by someone I don't know I will tell an adult.
 - ✓ All my communications will be polite and friendly.
 - ✓ I will never give out my own, or others', personal information (surname, address and phone number), passwords and named photographs.
 - ✓ I know I should follow the rules as part of the agreement with my teachers and trusted adults.
 - ✓ I know that if I am irresponsible or I break these rules, I might not be able to use a computer, device or the internet in school.
 - ✓ Year 5 and 6 – when using Microsoft Teams for online homework I will use this platform appropriately and follow the rules and guidance given by teachers.
