<p align="center"><b>National Non-Fiction November</b></p> <p>01.11.2024 is the start of National Non-Fiction November. Create a non-fiction fact file about something you are interested in. It could be about a sport, a sportsperson, history or a historical figure, a scientist, an animal – the list is endless and you can decide how to present your work.</p>	<p align="center"><b>Christmas</b></p> <p>Design and make a Christmas card for your class.</p>
<p align="center"><b>Music</b></p> <p>Listen to a piece of classical music – who was the composer? What was the piece of music called? What emotions and images did the music evoke?</p>	<p align="center"><b>Science</b></p> <p>Choose an animal and find out more information about it. What animal classification is it (mammal, fish, bird, reptile or amphibian) and why? Where does it live? What does it eat? Is it a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore? Is it warm/cold blooded? You can present this how you wish.</p>
<p align="center"><b>RE</b></p> <p align="center">Retell the Nativity Story.</p> <p>You can decide how you would like to present this. You might want to re-enact this with your family, sequence pictures, re-write it, create a stable scene etc.</p>	<p align="center"><b>Remembrance Day</b></p> <p>Find out about Remembrance Day. Why is it so important? Who do we remember and why? Why do people wear poppies? You might want to create a poppy wreath that we can put up in our classroom.
